Community Health Educator

General Statement of Duties:

This position consistently provides high quality health education and services to patients and the community. Assesses, plans, implements, evaluates, and coordinates health education programs.

Supervision Received:

Works under the supervision of the Community Health and Outreach Manager or designated supervisor.

Supervision Exercised:

None

Essential Functions:

- 1. Plan and provide education workshops in cooperation with various public and private community groups and agencies. May assist in providing monthly continuing in-service training and staff development to all agency staff as needed.
 - Serve as a specialist in health education for the agency and provide consultation to other departments.
 - Formulate, review, evaluate, and recommend the development of health education materials by others for use in the agency.
 - Serve as an agency representative at appropriate professional or community meetings or conferences.
 - Provide technical consultation and assistance to Northwest Colorado Health programs.
- 2. Establish and maintain cooperative relationships with educational, research, governmental and other agencies in relationship to health education services. Serves as a spokesperson in the area of Health Education.
 - Interpret and apply scientific knowledge of health education to professional and lay groups.
 - Assist in policy and procedure development for quality assurance issues, i.e. Safety and Infection Control Committee.
- 3. Provide health education counseling and/or presentations to individuals or groups according to planned objectives as referred or requested.
 - Teach classes for the community and health professionals in the areas of nutrition and lifestyle changes and others as they are needed.
- 4. Assist in the collection of statistical information of program participants to conduct studies and surveys as they relate to health and disease.
 - Actively participate in new program development.

This description of responsibilities is intended to provide the essential functions of the position. Additional responsibilities may be added as appropriate.

Education:

Bachelor's degree in a health-related field preferred.

Experience:

One year full-time employment or its equivalent in Community Health Education. Certification as CHES preferred.

Requirements:

- 1. If car is used, must provide proof of adequate insurance combined coverage totaling at least \$300,000 and a valid Colorado Driver's License.
- 2. Current immunization history, after job offer and before starting job.
- 3. Current CPR certification.

Skills:

- 1. Psychomotor skills to perform CPR.
- 2. Daily standing, squatting, walking, bending, and maneuvering in various settings (clinics, schools, work sites) which are not barrier free.
- 3. Proficiency in the use of audio and visual equipment.

Abilities:

- 1. Ability to communicate effectively with community members, physicians, and other health professionals, verbally and in writing.
- 2. Ability to plan and organize community and professional classes and presentations.

Working Conditions:

- 1. Work environment may be variable as services are provided in various environments. Lighting, acoustics, air quality, temperature, and environmental hazards are not predictable.
- 2. May work occasional nights and/or weekends.
- 3. This position meets the criteria for Category 2 of OSHA's guidelines for exposure to biohazards.
- 4. May include travel in all weather conditions.
