General Statement of Duties:

Facilitates communication between client and healthcare provider by verbal interpretation and written translation.

Supervision Received:

Works under the immediate supervision of a healthcare professional and the general direction of the clinic manager.

Supervision Exercised:

None.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Interpreting the client's own words as much as possible without paraphrasing, giving advice, inserting own comments, or making assumptions.
- 2. Interpreting the health professional's words exactly, changing them only to clarify the meaning of a word. The interpreter should always ask if she/he does not understand a word or idea to be interpreted.
- 3. Translating written information to be given to the client. Assisting the client in filling out various forms.

Education:

High school graduate preferred.

Experience:

- Experience in cross cultural interpretation, facial expressions and body movements that may be specific to the culture.
- 2. Previous experience in bilingual interpretation in a healthcare setting.

Requirements:

- 1. Current immunization history, after job offer and before starting job.
- 2. Must be fluent in Spanish/and English.
- 3. If car is used, must provide proof of adequate insurance coverage totaling at least
 - \$300,000 combined and valid Colorado driver's license.
- 4. Annual TB testing and/or screening.

Skills:

- 1. Adequate hearing to communicate. Must speak clearly and loudly enough to be heard.
- 2. Must be able to read and write in both English and Spanish.

Knowledge:

- 1. Agency and community service knowledge preferred.
- 2. Knowledge of medical terminology and/or nutrition preferred.

Abilities:

- 1. Must be friendly and able to establish rapport with clients.
- 2. Must be able to follow directions accurately.
- 3. Ability to adhere to the principles of confidentiality.

Equipment:

Telephone, computer, copier

Working Conditions:

- 1. Job involves sitting 50% of the day. Remainder of time may be spent standing, walking, reaching, or bending.
- 2. This position meets the criteria for category 3 of OSHA's guidelines for exposure to biohazards.
