- Level II Alcohol Education: This class fulfills Colorado DMV and Court requirements for a DUI case. Education consists of 12 Classes that are each 2 hours long. Each class is \$30. Please call the office to schedule an orientation before beginning classes: (970) 879 7708. We offer a Zoom education class at 10AM on Wednesday mornings and an in person education class at 5:30PM on Thursday evenings.
- Level II Alcohol Therapy: This class fulfills Colorado DMV and Court requirements for a DUI case. You must complete your Level II Education requirement before you begin therapy. Each class is \$30. Zoom therapy classes are offered at 10AM on Tuesday mornings or at 5:30PM on Tuesday evenings. We also offer an in-person class at 5:30 on Wednesday evenings.
- **Minor in Possession Course:** This is a two-day course offered on weekends to fulfill the Colorado Court requirements for an MIP charge. Students must be a minimum of 15 years old to attend. The class begins at 9am and ends at 1pm on Saturday and Sunday. The total cost of the class is \$120. Please call the office to schedule a weekend to attend.
- **Useful Public Service (UPS) Supervision:** RCAC oversees all court-mandated community service requirements for Routt County. We refer clients to the non-profits in town that are authorized to assign community service. The mandatory supervision and liability fee is \$120.
