## Northwest Colorado Care Transition Checklist and Commonly Needed Resources

- Did I get written discharge instructions explained to me and my primary caregiver? Discharge instructions should include:
  - Reason for admission, labs and diagnostics performed, procedures done, and important outcomes.
  - Who to contact if we need assistance after discharge.
  - What symptoms should we watch for and who should be called if we have concerns.
  - Updated medication list and how to ensure all my providers have an updated list.

• Follow up appointments needed and scheduling those appointments (see regional resources). NOTES:

Do I understand my follow up treatment and health recovery plan?

• Where will I receive therapy services - home, or outpatient? Who will provide those services?

• Does insurance cover these services and/or what kind of costs should be expected? Does my insurance impact my choice of provider (i.e. choose in network providers)?

• How long will follow up treatments be expected to last? What is the expected outcome (be sure to share your goals and concerns)?

□ What is my prognosis after hospitalization, and what types of assistance might be needed (especially if you are returning home to independent living, but also during care transition or if you will be residing in Assisted Living or other facility)?

- Functional status: Strength, ability to transfer safely, bathing, dressing, weakness, physical limitations.
- Household needs: How will I take care of the household including laundry, cleaning, shopping and meals (in compliance with nutritional needs/medical orders)?
- Transportation: Will I need rides to appointments or help with errands?

• Medication management: Do I know my medicine and why I need it? How will I get new medicine, discard old ones properly, manage a new medicine routine and communicate changes to all providers? NOTES:\_\_\_\_\_

□ Is my living environment safe given my current status/needs? This also applies to retirement communities and assisted living environments even though they are often already designed for accessibility and falls prevention.

• Do I need any special medical equipment? How I do I arrange to get the equipment? Do I need to pick up equipment and where can I do so? What is the cost? Does my insurance cover medical equipment?

• How safe is my physical environment? Have we completed a home safety/falls prevention checklist? (Contact us for a self-assessment/checklist).

• Do I have a personal emergency response system in case I fall or need to call for help? NOTES:

If you have concerns about the safety of returning home, talk to the hospital discharge planner and ask that steps be taken to ensure a safe transition care plan.
