Success will look like a well-organized, results-focused knowledgeable team where everyone is contributing, valued, engaged, and fulfilled in their work.

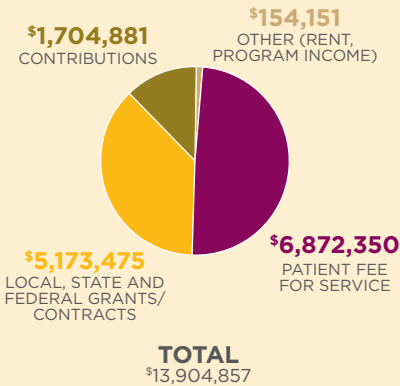
STRATEGY #4: EXPAND WHO KNOWS IT

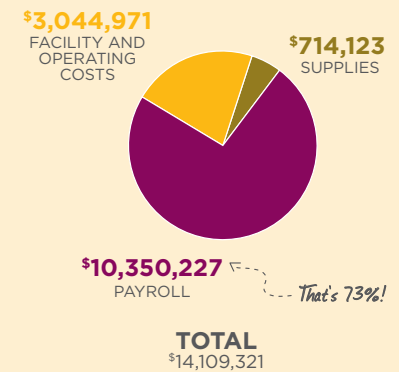

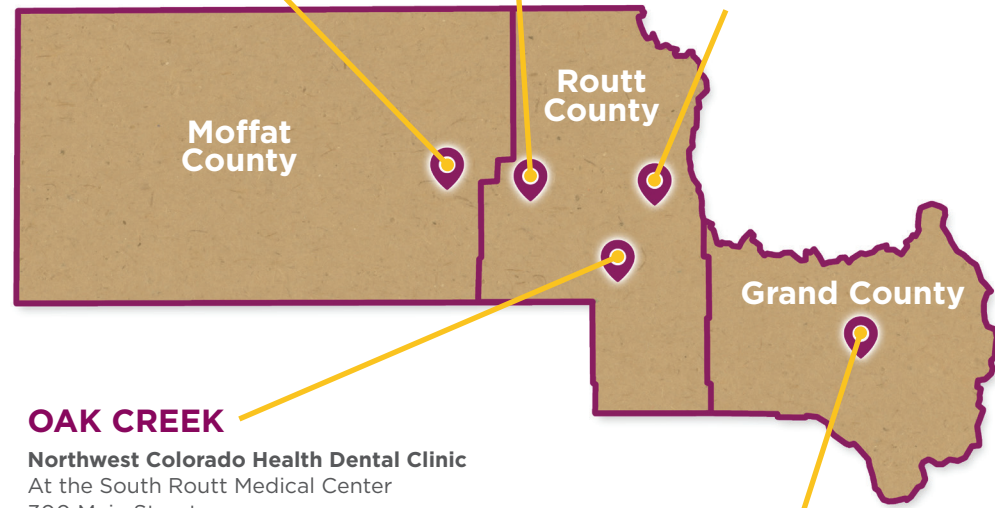
