2023 was a year focused on stability for Northwest Colorado Health. With recruitment and retention as a major focus, we are proud to say we maintained our retention rate and continued to expand our reach to meet the needs of our growing community. We employed 194 people who provided homes to 29 assisted living residents, cared for 238 people in their homes, provided 7,000 preventative care consults, held 7,120 interactions with youth who experienced trauma and adversity and provided over 21,000 medical, dental, and mental health visits in our clinics.

For almost sixty years, Northwest Colorado Health has been evolving to provide critical health and wellness resources, and we continue to take care of a third of the residents who call the Yampa Valley home. We value this role and would like to extend our deepest gratitude to our staff, patients, volunteers, community partners, funders, and donors for believing in our mission.

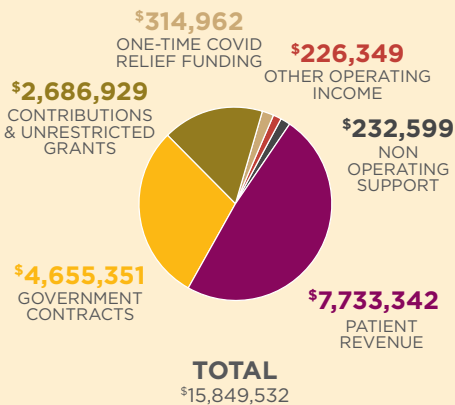

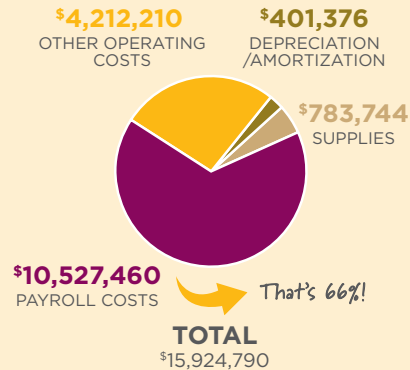
